## If the recipient of this document is not the owner of the premises concerned, this document must be forwarded to the owner without delay.

I refer to the emergency safety operations carried out on the 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2007 by Clackmannanshire Council at the above property and wish to comment as follows.

It was brought to the attention of this Authority that broken glass at the first floor level of the property was in a dangerous condition. During a subsequent inspection it was noted that large shards of glass were positioned in a dangerous condition above the adjacent public footpath.

This letter should be treated as formal notification of operations executed under Sub Section 3 of Section 29 (Dangerous Buildings) of the above Act. On receipt of the final account for the operations noted above, the costs shall be re-charged to the appropriate owners.

During the aforementioned inspection, the Council's Building Standards Team had the broken shards of glass removed and the window boarded up in order to remove the immediate danger presented to the general public.

I have enclosed for your information photographs of the premises, clearly showing the broken window at first floor level.
