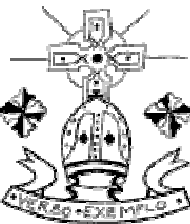

### Please note:

- For afterschool clubs, pupils will be collected from their classrooms at the end of the school day and escorted to the PE facility where their club will take place.
