- Car sharing scheme Tripshare Clacks launched
- Travel planning initiative introduced at Clackmannanshire Council including pool bikes and Cycle to Work scheme.

Walking

- Active Travel Routes implemented on National Cycle Network 76 and the Devon Way
- 14 new Zebra crossings introduced and 9 Puffin crossings
- Pedestrian bridges / ramps constructed across the railway
- Walkway constructed through the town centre between Alloa Station and Alloa Tower
- Widening and lighting of Waggon Way pedestrian / cycle route to new hospital and Sauchie

Road Network Improvement and Maintenance

- New roundabouts at Collyland Cross, Mary Wood, Parkmill and Parkhead Road/Hallpark Road
- Alloa Eastern Link Road
- B9140 re-alignment and widening between Collylands Roundabout and Glenochil
- Surface and Drainage Upgrading to Pitgober Road
