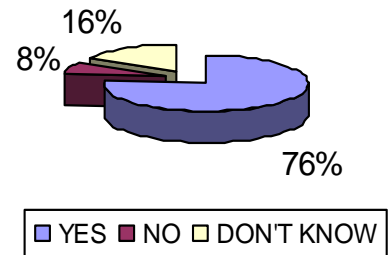

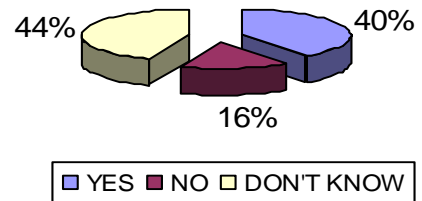

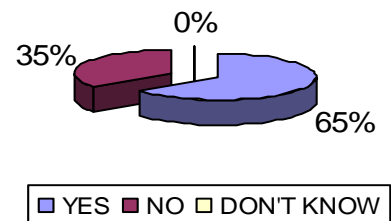
3 Has the picnic table and extra seating installed encouraged people to spend more time at the Delph Pond?

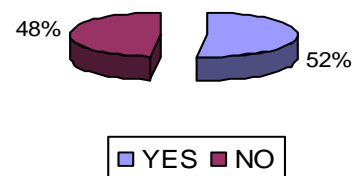

4 Are you aware that a group was recently formed to look at fishing in the Delph Pond and the environmental impact?



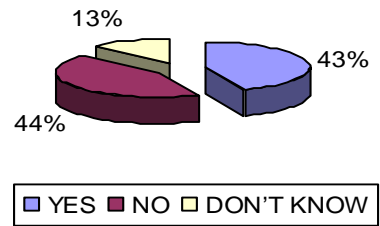

6 Do the improvements encourage people to take more care of the wildlife / report any problems with the wildlife or surrounding area?

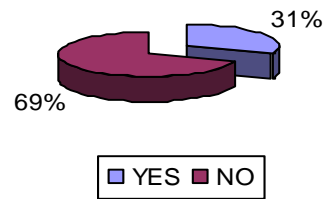
**Comments:**

- 1 Could do with another dog poop bin



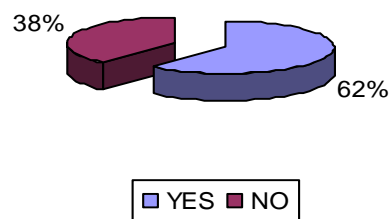
8 What else could we do to encourage people to use the bins, bins rather than drop their litter?

- 9 Sometimes

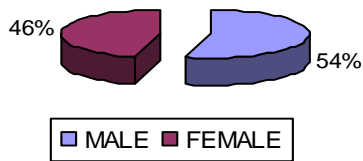


10 What else could we do to enhance the Delph Pond area and help to retain its natural beauty, whilst encouraging people to enjoy and make use of the space?

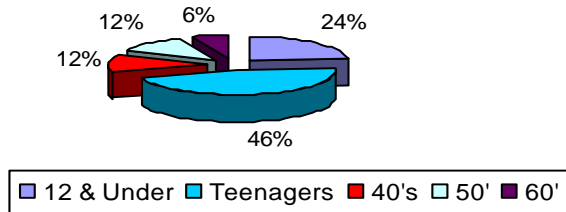
- 1 replant the bog garden area and dedicate a Ranger to the area full time
