DANGEROUS BUILDING NOTICE

Building (Scotland) Act 2003

Notice under Section 29 and 30 requiring owner to reduce or remove the danger constituted by a building

To:

As owner(s) of (address of dangerous building)

Ruinous Outbuildings to the Rear of 27, 27a, 29 & 29a Ochil Street, Alloa (as indicated on attached location plan)

It appearing to Clackmannanshire Council that the above building constitutes a danger that requires to be reduced or removed, the Council therefore require that the following steps must be taken to secure compliance with this notice.

The steps which must be taken are:

1. Demolish ruinous building and remove all material from site.

OR

2a. Secure the building and sufficient area of surrounding ground on all sides of the building preventing unauthorised access and ensuring the safety of the general public in relation to collapse of any/all portions of the ruinous building. Area to be secured to be agreed with the Building Standards Team.

AND

2b. Provide Clackmannanshire Council with a structural engineer's report on the building identifying defects and remedial action necessary to remove/reduce dangers presented by the building.

A building warrant is not required but a completion certificate must be provided.

1. Any applicant aggrieved by the requirements of this Notice may, within 21 days of the date of the Notice, appeal to the Sheriff.

2. Later dates may be substituted where there is an appeal, until the appeal is withdrawn or finally determined.

WARNING

If you fail to carry out the work specified in this Notice you may be guilty of an offence under the Building (Scotland) Act 2003 and liable on summary conviction to a fine. In addition, the Local Authority may carry out the work itself and claim from you as a debt any expenses reasonably incurred by it in doing so.
