RC.80 CIVIC LICENSING - GOVERNANCE AND MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS

RC.81 STREET TRADING SCHOOL RESTRICTIONS

The report was presented to the Regulatory Committee as part of the ongoing review of Civic Licensing and dovetails with Scottish Government publications released in 2014 regarding healthy eating in schools. The report set out proposals for consideration by the Committee to review the conditions of street traders licences as required by law; to consider the existing restriction on street trading that currently exists within a set distance of the three secondary schools operated by Clackmannanshire Council as the education authority; and extend the restrictions to all secondary schools located within Clackmannanshire. The report sought Committee approval to consult the general public, school head teachers, parent/teacher associations, Education Service, Scottish Government, Heart UK, NHS Scotland and street traders on the existing restrictions on street trading in and around the secondary school estate.
