DRAFT Role & Remit

- Demonstrate effectiveness of services and be able to answer question such as whether additional wards need to be opened over winter.
- Linking & driving tests of change to mainstream service delivery transformation.
- Change control management.
- Strategic Commissioning Plan development, engagement and delivery.
- Phase 2 ('16-'18) Integrated Care Programme development, engagement and delivery.
