Subject: Supported Bus Services
Report by: Head of Development & Environment

#### 1.0 Purpose

1.1. This report details to Committee the forthcoming changes to the Council's financed supported bus services in Clackmannanshire and updates on the Forth Valley Royal Hospital Services ('H' services).

#### 2.0 Recommendations

- 2.1. It is recommended that Committee:
  - note the intended changes to the Clackmannanshire Council financed supported bus services as detailed in section 4.3 of the report.
  - note the commencement of the revised supported bus services from August 2015, supported by a programme of communication and engagement between May - August 2015.
  - note the NHS Forth Valley have extended the current 'H' services up to March 2018 as detailed in section 4.8 of the report.

#### 3.0 Background

3.1. The Council currently finance four supported bus routes in Clackmannanshire. The table below sets out the bus services and their routes. Each of the routes is subsidised by the Council with subsidy ranging up to £18 per passenger per trip.

- 3.2. The Council as part of its budget consultation process consulted generally and with specific community groups on proposals to change the supported bus services. Public and service user feedback stated the locality based services were important as many areas of the supported bus services were not supported by commercial services, making it difficult for residents to travel across the county.
- 3.3. The Council in February 2015 approved £100,000 saving from the cost to provide supported bus services.

#### 4.0 Considerations

- 4.1 The current supported bus services are provided by two operators. One operator took the decision to terminate their contract with Clackmannanshire Council to operate supported bus services C64 and C70. A notice to this effect was issued giving the Council 3 months notice to terminate. As a result of this notice an interim provider of the C64 service has been provided.
- 4.2 Clackmannanshire Council's area is well supported by bus services with frequent Commercial services supported by the Council's four supported bus routes and the NHS Forth Valleys H<sub>1</sub> & H<sub>2</sub> service. As shown in Appendix 1 of the report.
- 4.3 Following review of the supported bus service provision, the Council seek to continue to finance supported bus services in Clackmannanshire. In order to deliver a more sustainable service the following changes will be introduced to the supported bus services. The changes to service provision are set out below:

C70 - This service will be withdrawn when current operator withdraws delivery on 17 May 2015.

C64, C68 & C69 - These services will be replaced by three new supported bus routes the C1, C2 and C3 services.

- 4.4 The C1, C2 and C3 bus services will operate on a 2½ hourly frequency, on a Monday Saturday basis from 8.00 am 6.00 pm. The new timetable is attached as Appendix 3.
- 4.5 The map in Appendix 2 of the report outlines the bus route for each of the new bus services. The new bus services continue to service our communities of greatest need on a geographical basis where commercial bus services are not available and where the supported bus services are in demand used by communities.
- 4.6 The areas no longer supported by supported bus services C1, C2 and C3 are Menstrie, Dollar, Whins Road, Gaberston, Alloa Park, Greenside Street, Smithfield Loan (part) and Parkway. These areas will no longer be served on the basis of a frequent commercial service provision in close proximity and/or very low passenger numbers.
- 4.7 The C1, C2 and C3 supported bus services will come into operation on Monday 17 August 2015, immediately after the school holidays. The new services will be widely marketed in the local press, social media, poster and leaflets in buses and in communities and through face to face attendance at Community Councils and other community organisations. The services will support users to transfer to the new services.
- 4.8 The NHS Forth Valley in awarding a new contract to deliver the H<sub>1</sub> & H<sub>2</sub> service to March 2018 contracted the service on the basis of a Monday Saturday service. The 'H' services have therefore been withdrawn on a Sunday. This change came into effect from mid April 2015. For residents seeking to access the Forth Valley Royal Hospital by public transport on a Sunday can access the commercial service C60.

### 5.0 Sustainability Implications




