

#### (ALLOA TOWN CENTRE) WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2014

The Clackmannanshire Council hereinafter referred to as "the Council" in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and 32(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Alloa Town Centre) (Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2014, and shall come into operation on the 9 May 2014.
- 2. This order amends "The Clackmannanshire Council (Alloa Town Centre) (Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions) Order 2011", by amending Schedule 65 as detailed in the Schedule to this Amendment Order. Schedule 66 to "The Clackmannanshire Council (Alloa Town Centre) (Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions) Order 2011" is hereby revoked.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of Act of Parliament.
- 4. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:-
  - (a) "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland)
     Act 1984 and includes any verge or footway;
  - (b) "taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 23 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

- (c) "vehicle" means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along road whether by animal or mechanical power;
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 7(a), (b), (c) and (d) of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause any vehicle other than a taxi to wait during the periods specified and on the sections of road specified in Schedule 65 to this Order.
- 6. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any road specified in Schedule 65 to this Order at any time.
  - (a) if the vehicle in the service of or employed by the Postmaster General is being used for the purposes of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (b) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said lengths of road of any sewer or main, pipe apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act;
  - (c) where the vehicle is used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or any vehicle in the service of the local authority in either case being used in pursuance of statutory power or duties;
  - (d) where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop.

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- 7. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing a pedal cycle not propelled by mechanical power to wait in any of the said roads.
- 8. For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be deemed to wait or stop:
  - (a) if any point in that road is below the vehicle or its load and the vehicle is stationary;
  - (b) for more than a specified period in the same place if any point in that road is below the vehicle or its load throughout a period exceeding the specified period whether or not the vehicle is moved during that period.
- 9. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Acts.
- 10. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a Provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition then the provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule 65 (Section to be amended) - side and section of road on which there is no stopping at any time except for taxis: Mill Street, Alloa (North West Side: from a point 17 metres or thereby north-east of the east kerbline of High Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres or thereby); and Schedule 66 (To be Revoked) - side and section of road on which there is no stopping except for taxis between the hours of 6.00 pm and 6.00 am, Thursday to Sunday inclusive (North West Side: from a point 44 metres or thereby north east of the east kerbline of High Street, in a north easterly direction for a distance of 11 metres or thereby). Anyone wishing to question the validity of any of the provisions within this order should write to the Court of session within six weeks of 9 May 2014.
