**(KELLIE PLACE, ALLOA)
(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2015**

The CLACKMANNANSHIRE COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Kellie Place, Alloa) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2015" and shall come into operation on the 20 November 2015.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order other than in the direction specified in the said Schedule and shown on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto.
4. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the aforesaid Act or that if any requirement therein has not been complied with, may, within six weeks from 20 November 2015 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

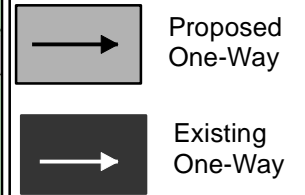
