

(FOOTPATH FROM COURTHILL TO DUKE STREET, ALVA) (STOPPING-UP) ORDER 2018

The Clackmannanshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 68(1) (a) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Footpath from Courthill to Duke Street, Alva) (Stopping-Up) Order 2018 and shall come into operation on 02 March 2018.
- 2. The effect of this Order shall be to stop-up the section of footpath as detailed in the schedule hereto to improve public safety and minimise incidents of public nuisance.
- 3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said footpath is stopped-up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across this footpath for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall after the commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.

The Council has made the above Order under Section 68(1) (a) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to stop-up the footpath from Duke Street and Courthill, Alva to improve public safety and to minimise incidents of public safety. **Schedule - Section of footpath over which the stopping up order applies**: **Duke Street - Courthill, Alva** (Entire length of footpath between Duke Street and Courthill, Alva). Alternative Route: Via footpath along Beauclerc Street to Courthill, Alva. Anyone wishing to question the validity of any of the provisions within this order should write to the Court of Session within six weeks of 02/03/18. Clackmannanshire Council has made an Order under Section 68(1) (a) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 on DATE, which will be to stop-up the section of footpath as detailed in the Schedule to improve public safety and minimise incidents of public nuisance.
