

(A91 HIGH STREET, TILLICOULTRY) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2019

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Street, Town) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019" and notwithstanding the date hereof, Schedule shall come into operation at 1245 hours on Sunday 16th June 2019 and will remain in operation until 1300 hours on that day.
- 2. The effect of this Order shall be to close to vehicles:-

During the period from 1245 hours until 1300 hours on Sunday 16th June 2019, on the section of roads described in Schedule. The temporary closure is required to facilitate a procession for the Gala day. The rolling road closure will assist Police Scotland in their duties.
