



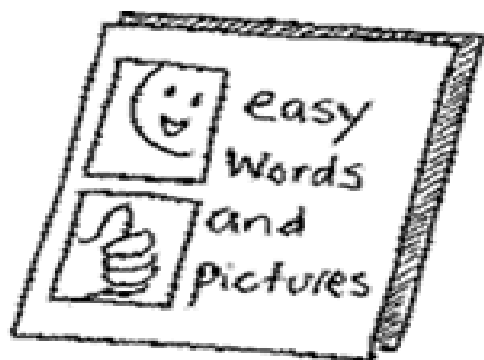

Photography



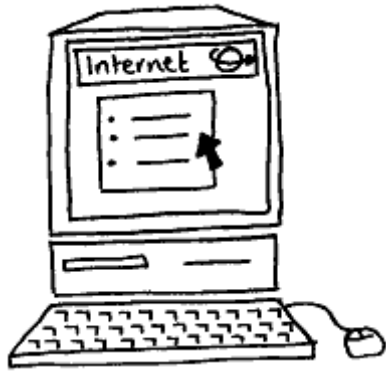

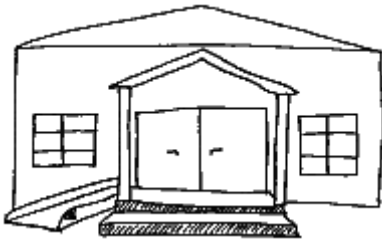


Getting a job

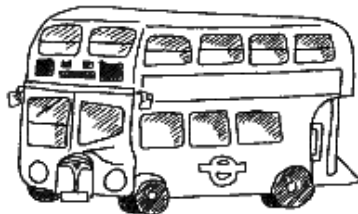
