College Parking on Devon Road

Thank you for your patience during the construction phase of the new College. Works are almost complete and the students are due to arrive on the 6th September.

We have been keeping a close eye on things and have noticed that over the past couple of months there have been works vans and cars parked on Devon Road near to the college access road. We are concerned that once the students start to arrive they may also choose to park on the street outside your homes. We are also concerned that students and other visitors to the college may try to park in the garage courts behind your homes.

We would prefer not to have students' cars parked on Devon Road therefore we are considering placing a single yellow line on each side from the new college access road as far as Earn Court. This would mean that no-one could park at the roadside between 9am to 5pm on Mondays to Fridays. Although there would be no parking on-street during these times, delivery vehicles, disabled badge holders and dropping off and picking up would be allowed. There would be no restriction on parking after 5 pm and before 9 am. We also intend to erect signs at the entrances to the garage court stating 'resident parking only'.
