College Parking on Hillcrest Drive & Hawkhill Road

Thank you for your patience during the construction phase of the new College. Works are almost completed and the students are due to arrive on the 6th September.

We have been keeping a close eye on things and have noticed that over the past couple of months there have been some works vans and cars parked on Hillcrest Drive and Hawkhill Road near to the college access road. We are concerned that once the students start to arrive they may also choose to park on the street outside your houses.

We would prefer not to have students' cars parked on your streets therefore we are considering the implementation of a controlled parking zone. This would allow us to stop students parking but would unfortunately also prevent your visitors from parking on-street during the day. Resident parking would be by permit only and only for vehicles registered at that address.

We appreciate that the above option may seem a little restrictive but unfortunately it is the only way that we can prohibit students and other visitors to the college from parking on your street. However, there will be no student entrances to the college at this side of the building. Students will have to walk round to the front to enter the college so they may not choose to park in Hawkhill Road or Hillcrest Drive.

This is your chance to comment and we would like to hear your views. You may feel that it would be better not to go for a controlled parking zone right away but to wait to see if parking becomes a problem when the college opens.
