College parking on Devon Road

You may recall a consultation letter in July this year on college parking on Devon Road. The college opened in September and it has become clear that an on-street parking problem is occurring on Devon Road and this is being created by college traffic.

The earlier consultation mentioned proposals to place a single yellow line on each side of Devon Road from the college access as far as Earn Court. With this problem occurring we are proposing to install the yellow line, but before doing so we thought we would remind you of what is involved. Within the lined area no-one will be able to park at the roadside between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays. However, delivery vehicles, disabled badge holders and dropping off and picking up would be allowed. There would be no restriction on parking after 5pm and before 9am.

You may have noticed that we have already erected signs at some garage court entrances stating "residents parking only". We feel this and the proposed single yellow line on Devon Road will reduce the current college parking on Devon Road.
