### Summary

A study carried out by Audit Scotland showed that the cost per pupil for secondary education in Clackmannanshire was the 8th highest in Scotland, and is comparable with rural authorities that have significant transport costs. A similar authority such as Midlothian was 13th on the list. Also, the number of promoted posts in secondary schools in Clackmannanshire is higher than other local authorities.

This business case seeks to bring Clackmannanshire in line with similar local authorities, increase efficiency, standardise second

### Impact

Changes would impact on the promoted element of the post only and would not affect teacher numbers.

Teachers' conditions of service entitle them to 3 years salary conservation. Therefore it will take 4 years to fully achieve the savings.
