If they are not, discuss getting a fit note with your GP or clinician.</p> <p><b>School/ formal Childcare</b> Parents or guardians should discuss with their GP or clinician whether children should still attend</p>	<p><b>Contact with others</b> Minimise contact with people outside your own household if you can.  You should not take public transport.</p> <p><b>Shopping</b> Strictly follow the guidelines when shopping and limiting the number of times you go to a shop. Shop at quieter times.</p> <p><b>If you cannot work from home</b> The Chief Medical Officer will issue an automatic two week fit note to give people on the shielding list protection while they speak to their GP or consultant and get a personal fit note if necessary.</p> <p><b>School/ formal Childcare</b> Children on the shielding list should not attend in person.</p>
