Our Wider Achievements:




- We continue to offer 1 educator running the THRIVE to keep well project in the community.

- We host our own Toddler Group on Mondays 9:45-10;45 @ Sauchie ELC.
- We achieved our Silver Rights respecting school award and were awarded our silver status.
- We achieved our Full STEM nation award and are the first ELC setting in Clackmannanshire to achieve the FULL STEM NATION AWARD.
- We continue to develop our intergenerational partnerships in the community and still attend Beechwood Care home to visit. This year we also established a new relationship with Marchglen Care home too.
- We are working to become Promise Committed. We look forward to exploring this initiative more in the upcoming year and progressing this work further.
