What is 16 Days of Activism?

16 Days of Activism against Gender-Based Violence is an international campaign that calls for the prevention and elimination of Violence Against Women and Girls. It was started by activists at the inaugural Women's Global Leadership Institute in 1991 and continues to be coordinated each year by the Centre for Women's Global Leadership.

It starts on the 25th of November, the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women and ends on the 10th of December, the Human Rights Day. This year, in Forth Valley, we are organising a series of events, where we will raise awareness of this issue and the resources available in the area.
