



Community update – 14 July 2026

We understand that this continues to be a difficult and unsettling time for residents and families. We are continuing to work together with Clackmannanshire Council, Police Scotland, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service and other partners to keep people safe and provide updates as our investigations progress. We want to keep you informed about the work taking place and what it means for the community.

Resident access

We are continuing to support access for residents safely. From week commencing Monday 13 July, we will be working with the council to support residents with large scale removals from several properties, this means access for essential belongings will be on **Friday 17 July**.

- Dunmoss View: 1-2pm
- Nechtan Drive: 2-3pm
- Benbuck View: 3-4pm

Please contact the Council's dedicated helpline on 01259 452010 to arrange your booking. To help keep everyone safe, please do not come to site without a confirmed booking through the Council. Unfortunately, access cannot be provided without this confirmed booking.

We recognise that some residents may not be able to attend during the allotted time slots to collect essential belongings. If you cannot attend at these times, please contact our Community Liaison Officer, Sarah McDaid, who will help coordinate a time by special arrangement where it is safe to do so. All other bookings must be made through the Council's dedicated helpline.

Monitoring and investigations

Last week, we continued monitoring and investigation work across the site to help us build a clearer understanding of the ground conditions below the surface.

This week, drilling will continue at The Glen and Dunmoss View. Drilling work will also now take place on Benbuck View and Nechtan Drive. We will also carry out geophysical surveys on Benbuck View and Dunmoss View to help build a clearer understanding of ground conditions below the surface.



This week, we plan to begin drilling on Langour. We will work closely with residents throughout this period. Residents who may require removals or storage of household goods and access should contact the Council via councilincident@clacks.gov.uk or 01259 452010.

Geophysical surveys are continuing on Benbuck View and Dunmoss View to help build a clearer picture of ground conditions below the surface. LiDAR surveys are also planned for the weekend so we can continue to compare movement over time. Structural inspections are ongoing and we will continue to share updates as this work progresses.
