Section 38(4) of The Licensing (Scotland) Act, 2005 (the Act) requires that where the Licensing Standards Officer for the area receives a copy of a Premises Licence Review Application, then that officer must prepare a report for the benefit of the Licensing Board

1. On 28 November, 2022, I received a copy of a premises licence review application lodged by Police Scotland in connection with concerns raised about the Cross Keys public House at 118 Stirling Street, Alva.
2. The content of the Police review application is self explanatory and there is no information that I can usefully add to the information in that document.
3. The Licensing Board should note that as a result of this matter, the premises manager who was appointed to the premises for the period from July 2022 until its eventual closure in November, 2022, has surrendered her personal licence.
4. That premises manager maintained that she was unaware of any issues connected to drugs misuse on the premises.
5. The premises manager suggested that she was unaware that she had been nominated as premises manager and that she was unaware of what that responsibility entailed.
