1.0 Purpose

3.1. At its last meeting the Board was advised of the requirement to produce two annual reports (functions and financial) in accordance with section 56 of the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015.

3.2. The Annual Functions Report must include the following

(a) a statement explaining how the Board has had regard to-

(i) the licensing objectives, and

(ii) their licensing policy statement and any supplementary licensing policy statement in the exercise of their functions under this Act during the financial year,

(b) a summary of the decisions made by (or on behalf of) the Board during the financial year, and

(c) information about the number of licences held under this Act in the Board's area (including information about the number of occasional licences issued during the year).

3.3. The Annual Financial Report must include the following

(a) statement of

(i) the amount of relevant income received by the Licensing Board during the financial year, and

(ii) the amount of relevant expenditure incurred in respect of the Board's area during the year, and

(b) an explanation of how the amounts in the statement were calculated.

3.4 **Outline Report – Appendix one**

In accordance with the discussion at the last Board meeting an outline report has been prepared for this meeting to allow members to suggest any content that they wish to see included. This outline is based on a review of other Boards' reports and also consideration of the Alcohol Focus Scotland (AFS) Review which was published in March 2019.

In addition the Clerk has emailed all individuals and organisations that contributed to the consultation on the review of the Statement of Licensing Policy seeking their input in terms of the content of the report. This targeted consultation was to address the suggestion in the AFS report that members of the public be included in determining the content of the report.

Finally members will note that as previously agreed the functions and financial reports will be incorporated into a single document.

3.5 AFS Review

Members are reminded of the recommendations from AFS's review in March 2019

- 1. Ensure that annual functions reports are made widely available and publicised
- 2. Consult with local stakeholders regarding the Boards approach to the annual functions reports
- 3. Use the annual functions report as a mechanism to help monitor the implementation of local licensing policies
- 4. Identify whether there are any gaps in the licensing data being collected
