Civic Government (Scotland) Act, 1982 Application for the renewal of Taxi Drivers Licence David Lee,

- 1. In terms of Schedule 1, paragraph 3 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act, 1982 (the Act) I wish to make a representation in relation to the renewal of a taxi drivers licence to David Lee
- 2. This representation asks that the Regulatory Committee consider the information contained in paragraphs 3-10, before coming to a decision as to whether or not David Lee (the applicant) is a fit and proper person to be hold a Taxi Drivers Licence.
- 3. The applicant has declared a single road traffic conviction on his renewal application.
- 4. The conviction relates of an offence driving without due care and attention causing a serious injury road accident.
- 5. The circumstances are that at 11.20am on 22 September 2020, the accused whilst driving a taxi collided with a cyclist in Alloa town centre. The cyclist suffered from serious injuries.
- 6. The accident occurred at very low speed, and appears to have occurred as a result of a momentary lapse in concentration.
- 7. The cyclist suffered a fractured wrist, which is categorised as a "serious" injury for the purposes of statistical recording.
- 8. There was a fare paying passenger in the taxi at the time. The passenger was not injured.
- 9. The applicant pled guilty to the offence and was fined £100 and had 3 points place on his driving licence
- 10. The applicant has no other convictions.

- 11. The applicant fully complied with the conditions of his taxi drivers licence at and made all of the required notifications to the licensing authority in relation to the incident and subsequent conviction..
- 12. Due to the nature and circumstances of the accident and conviction, the relatively recent occurrence and the relevancy to the type of licence applied for, this application should not be granted under delegated powers, and should be determined by the Regulatory Committee.
- 13. The regulatory committee are asked to consider this representation along with any other information presented to them and determine whether or not the applicant is a fit an proper person to hold a taxi drivers licence
