### Civic Government (Scotland) Act, 1982 Application for Taxi Drivers Licence John Stein Gold McDonald

- 1. In terms of Schedule 1, paragraph 3 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act, 1982 (the Act) I wish to make a representation in relation to the grant of a Taxi Drivers licence to John Stein Gold McDonald
- 2. This representation asks that the Regulatory Committee consider the information contained in paragraphs 3-10, before coming to a decision as to whether or not John McDonald (the applicant) is a fit and proper person to be hold a Taxi Drivers Licence.
- 3. The applicant has declared a single road traffic conviction on his application.
- 4. The conviction relates of an offence of failing to stop at the scene of an injury road accident and failing to subsequently report this road accident to the Police.
- 5. The circumstances are that the accused whilst driving a taxi collided with a pedestrian in Alloa town centre and ultimately drove off without stopping.
- 6. He failed to comply with the requirements of the road traffic legislation by not stopping at the scene and furnishing his particulars to any injured party and not subsequently reporting the matter to the Police.
- 7. The applicant pled guilty to the offences.
- 8. Shortly after the incident Mr McDonald surrendered his taxi drivers licence, in a letter claiming to have "retired"
- 9. Due to the nature and circumstances of the matter surrounding his conviction, the relatively recent occurrence and the relevancy to the type of licence applied for, this application should not be granted under delegated powers, and should be determined by the Regulatory Committee.
- 10. The regulatory committee are asked to consider this representation along with the other information presented to them and determine whether or not the applicant is a fit an proper person to hold a taxi drivers licence
