Civic Government (Scotland) Act, 1982 Application for Taxi Drivers Licence Stephen Honeyman,

- 1. In terms of Schedule 1, paragraph 3 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act, 1982 (the Act) I wish to make a representation in relation to the grant of a Taxi Drivers licence to Stephen Honeyman,
- This representation asks that the Regulatory Committee consider the information contained in paragraphs 3-10, before coming to a decision as to whether or not Stephen Honeyman (the applicant) is a fit and proper person to be hold a Taxi Drivers Licence.
- 3. The applicant has declared a single road traffic conviction on his application.
- 4. The applicant was advised to seek professional advice in relation to other convictions that he has in order to identify which convictions are now spent and protected from the requirements to declare them on a taxi driver's application.
- 5. It is clear from the information reported by Police Scotland in a separate report that he did not take that advice and as result has failed to declare convictions that he is required to declare on his application.
- 6. Full details of the convictions are contained within a representation made by Police Scotland and I have nothing further to add in relation to those.
- 7. The applicant was found not to be a fit and proper person to hold a taxi drivers licence in 2020.
- 8. The content of the Police Scotland objection shows that the applicant has engaged in an extended pattern of behaviour in relation to driving habits and decisions that has no doubt placed other road users at risk.
- 9. The applicant has failed to take notice of specific advice to assist him in the application process and as a result he has again failed to correctly declare convictions that he is required by law to admit on a taxi driver application.
- 10. Due to the nature and circumstances of these convictions, their relatively recent occurrence and their relevancy to the type of licence applied for, this application should not be granted under delegated powers, and should be determined by the Regulatory Committee.

11. The regulatory committee are asked to consider this representation along with the other information presented to them and determine whether or not the applicant is a fit an proper person to hold a taxi drivers licence
