



4 x Occasional Licence Applications - Outdoor Area

Applicant- Caledonian Heritable Limited Car Park area adjacent, and to the East of The Holly Tree Inn, Main Street East, Menstrie.

Section 57(1)(b) of The Licensing (Scotland) Act, 2005 (the Act) requires that the Licensing Board notifies the Licensing Standards Officer for the area in relation to any application for an occasional licence. This section further provides that the Licensing Standards Officer is provided with a copy of the application.

Having considered the content of the applications to which this representation relates, I have the following comments to make:

- This representation relates to 4 occasional licences each lasting for a period of 14 days, and seeking authority to make sales of alcohol for on sales consumption in an outdoors space which is not currently part of the licensed footprint of the premises at the above address.
- 2. I would highlight an error in the application which indicates that the location to be licensed lies to the **East** of the premises, when in fact the location on the attached plan and the area discussed with the applicants agent lies to the West side of the building at the junction of Park Road. I have <u>again</u> reported on the basis that this in an error.
- I have included a image of the location and area to be licensed at Appendix B
- 4. The 4 applications seek to licence the premises from 13 August 2021 for a continuous period of 8 weeks until 7 October 2021.
- The purpose of an occasional licence is to allow premises that are not normally licensed to be licensed "occasionally". Not necessarily for a special event or special occasion.

- 6. The applicant is aware that they should be looking to a more permanent licensing solution if they wish to continue the use of this area in the longer term during 2021.
- 7. The land in this case is an area used for car parking at the side of the premises and is owned by the premises.
- 8. The applicant has been advised that he should only use personal licence holders or other staff trained to the standards required by the Licensing (Training of Staff)(Scotland) Regulations 2007 to sell alcohol at the premises.
- 9. I have previously discussed the likely conditions that may be applied to the outdoor area if the licenses are granted and referred the applicant to the Clackmannanshire Licensing Board statement of Licensing Policy where he will able to able to see sample local conditions, similar to those contained within Appendix A
- 10. The applicant has also been advised that any staff left in charge at the premises should be the holder of a personal licence or should be able to make immediate contact with a personal licence holder responsible for the management of the premises, during all licensed hours.
- 11. Outdoor areas, particularly those adjacent to public places require close supervision and careful management to avoid conflict with the licensing objectives. The Board may wish to explore with the applicant any proposals that they have for supervision and management of the area.
- 12. Appendix A contains a list of suggested conditions that the Licensing Board may wish to impose on granting this application. These conditions are necessary to ensure compliance with the licensing objectives contained within The Licensing (Scotland) Act, 2005.

# Appendix A

- 1 Alcohol sold for consumption in the licensed outdoor area will be ordered from, and delivered to the table, by staff employed at the Holly Tree Inn.
- 2 The outdoor area must be clearly separated from any neighbouring unlicensed area by a physical barrier such as a fence or series of posts and rope or tape of at least 1 metre in height.
- 3 The outside area can only be occupied by persons seated at a table.
- 4 The licence holder must ensure that alcohol is only consumed by persons seated at a table.
- 5 Only alcohol sold by the Hollytree Inn will be permitted by the licence holder to be consumed in the outdoor area
- 6 All drinks whether alcoholic or not sold or supplied for consumption in the outdoor area, will be sold in or decanted into plastic or polycarbonate drinking vessels.
