

(QUEEN STREET, ALVA) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2017

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Queen Street, Alva) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2017" and notwithstanding the date hereof shall come into operation on the 22nd February 2017.
- The effect of this Order shall be to close to vehicles: The period from 0001 hours on Monday 6th March 2017 for a period of 10 weeks or until works are completed whichever is soonest, on the section described in the Schedule attached. The temporary closure is required for resurfacing works.

Diversion Route: Via Beauclerc Street, Brook Street, The Green, The Wynd, Park Street and vice versa. The order runs from 0001 hours on Monday 6th March 2017 for a period of 10 weeks until works are completed whichever is soonest, and is necessary for resurfacing works.
