

(B910 RICCARTON TO LINN MILL) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2018

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (B910 Riccarton to Linn Mill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018" and notwithstanding the date hereof, Schedule shall come into operation at 0800 hours on Tuesday 26th June 2018 and will remain in operation until 2000 hours on Wednesday 27th June 2018.
