



**(VARIOUS STREETS, DOLLAR)
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2019**

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Various Streets, Dollar) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019" and notwithstanding the date hereof, Schedule shall come into operation at 1245 hours on Saturday 1st June 2019 and will remain in operation until 1320 hours on that day.
2. The effect of this Order shall be to close to vehicles:-

During the period from 1245 hours until 1320 hours on Saturday 1st June 2019, on the section of roads described in Schedule. The temporary closure is required to facilitate a procession for the Dollar Gala Parade. The rolling road closure will assist Police Scotland in their duties.

The Council has made "The Clackmannanshire Council (Various Streets, Dollar) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) on 25th April 2019: to close to vehicles the section of road at **Manor House Road** (at its junction with Cairnpark Street, a distance of 15 metres or thereby), **Cairnpark Street** (from its junction with Manor House Road southwards for a distance of 130 metres or thereby), **A91 Bridge Street** (from its junction with Cairnpark Street eastwards until its junction with Park Place, a distance of 140 metres or thereby), **Park Place** (from its junction with A91 Bridge Street southwards then eastwards until its junction with the entrance to Dollar Civic centre, a distance of 200 metres or thereby. The order runs from 1245 hours until 1320 hours on Saturday 1st June 2019 and is required to facilitate a procession for the Dollar Gala Parade. The rolling road closure will assist Police Scotland in their duties. 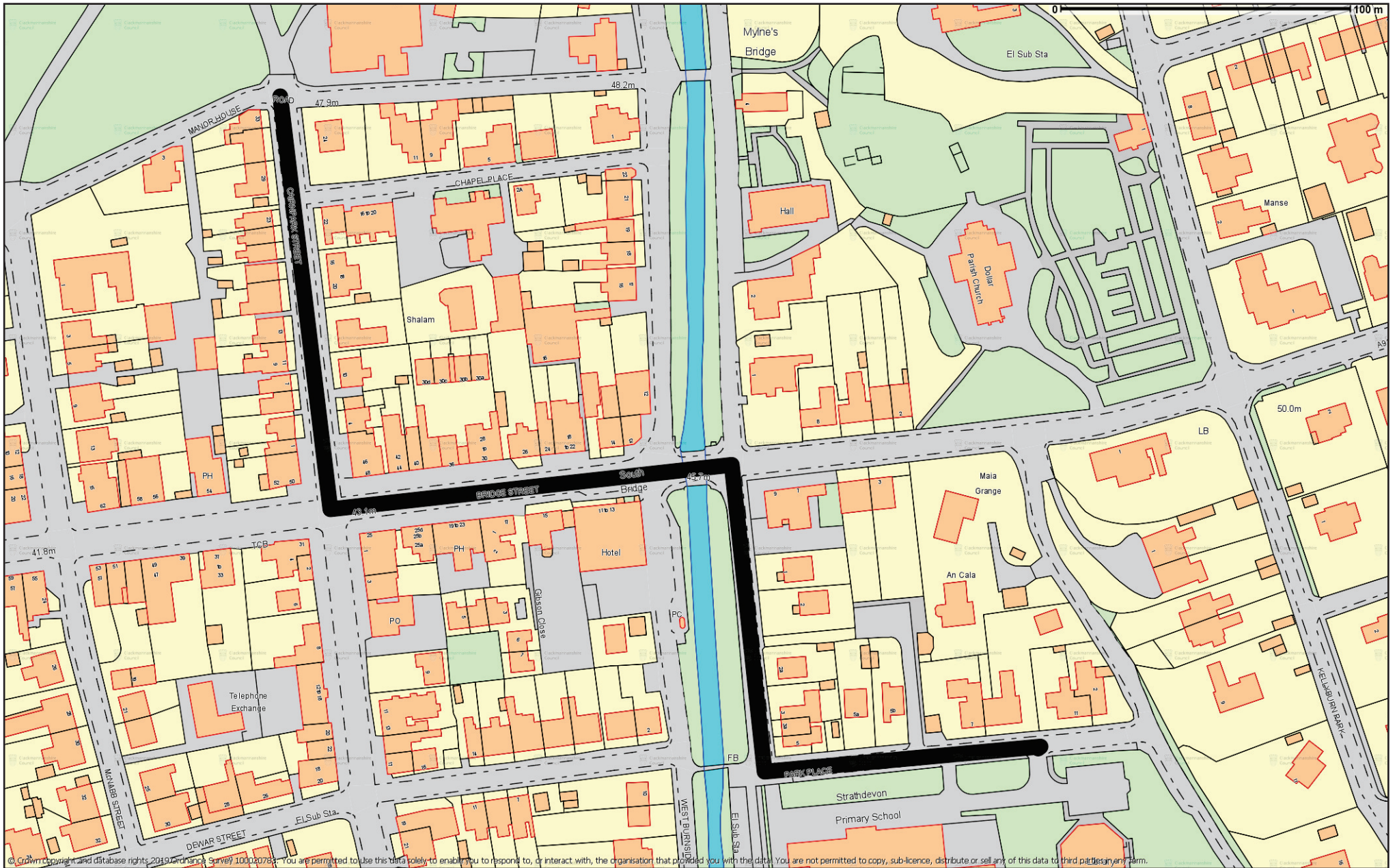
