

(PARKING SPACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS) (VARIOUS STREETS, CLACKMANNANSHIRE) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2022

Clackmannanshire Council in exercise of their powers under Section 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons) (Various Streets, Clackmannanshire) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the 15th April 2022.
- 2. The effect of this Order will be to designate the sections of road described in the Schedule hereto and shown on the plans annexed and signed as relative hereto as parking spaces for disabled persons' vehicles.
- 3. This order amends "The Clackmannanshire Council (Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons) (Various Streets, Clackmannanshire) Order 2016; "The Clackmannanshire Council (Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons) (Various Streets, Clackmannanshire) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2016"; and "The Clackmannanshire Council (Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons) (Various Streets, Clackmannanshire) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2018" by adding Parking Space Nos. 157, 158, 159, 160 and 161 to the Schedules to these orders.
- 4. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - (a) "disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge issued, or having effect as if issued under any regulations for the time being in force under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;
 - (b) "disabled person" means the disabled driver of or a disabled passenger in a motor vehicle, being such a disabled person as is described in regulation 4 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 in respect of whom any Council has issued a disabled person's badge and a valid badge is conspicuously displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle;
 - (c) "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

- (d) "relevant position" means:
 - in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the disabled person's badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse site facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; and
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle.




