

(DEVONWAY, CLACKMANNAN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, PARKING AND LOADING) ORDER 2022

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Devonway, Clackmannan) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Parking and Loading) Order 2022" and notwithstanding the date hereof, the Schedule shall come into operation at 0800 hours on Monday 4th July 2022 and will remain in operation until 1700 hours on Friday 15th July 2022.
- 2. The effect of this Order is that there will be no driving, parking or loading at any time during:

The period from 0800 hours on Monday 4th July 2022 until 1700 hours on Friday 15th July 2022, on the section of roads described in Schedule. The temporary prohibition of driving, parking and loading is required for carriageway resurfacing, safety of the workforce and members of the public.
