

(LOWER COBDEN STREET, ALVA) (STOPPING-UP) ORDER 2022

The Clackmannanshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 68(1) (a) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Lower Cobden Street, Alva) (Stopping-Up) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on 30th November 2022.
- 2. The effect of this Order shall be to stop-up the section of road as detailed in the schedule hereto as it is required to increase safety for pedestrians due to the new layout on A91 Stirling Street. Local residents have indicated support for this permanent closure as it has been temporarily closed during the upgrade works on A91 Stirling Street. The road will be removed from the list of adopted roads.
- 3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said road is stopped-up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across this road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall after the commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.
