



**(DOLLAR ROAD, TILlicOUNTRY)
(TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022**

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Dollar Road, Tillicoultry) (Temporary Footway Closure) Order 2022" and notwithstanding the date hereof shall come into operation at 0730 hours on Monday 28th November 2022 and will remain in operation until 1600 hours on Friday 16th December 2022.
2. The effect of this Order shall be to close to pedestrians:-
The period from 0730 hours on Monday 28th November 2022 until 1600 hours on Friday 16th December 2022, on the section described in the Schedule attached. The temporary footway closure is required to carry out footway resurfacing works.
