

**THE CLACKMANNANSHIRE COUNCIL
(VARIOUS STREETS, FISHCROSS)
(20 MPH LIMIT) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2023**

Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 9, 10 (2), 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (Various Streets, Fishcross) (20 mph Limit) Experimental Order 2023" and shall come into operation on 2 February 2024 and will apply for a period of up to 18 months.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (3) A speed limit of 20 miles per hour is hereby imposed on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order and no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the said lengths of roads.
- (4) The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- (5) The Strategic Director (Place) of Clackmannanshire Council may, if it appears to them essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient, or safe movement of traffic, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area, and after such consultation and notice as are required by law, modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provisions of it in accordance with Section 10(2) of said Act.

The Council proposes to make the above Experimental Order under Sections 9, 10(2), 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will designate these sections of road as a 20 MPH speed limit to trial a reduction in the speed limit in the interests of road safety:- **B9140 Collylands Road, Fishcross:** from its junction with The Engine Green, eastwards until its junction with A908 Alloa Road, a distance of 90 metres or thereby; **B9140 Pitfairn Road, Fishcross:** from its junction with A908 Alloa Road eastwards until a point 25 metres or thereby east of its junction with Coalpots Way, a distance of 340 metres or thereby; **A908 Alloa Road, Fishcross:** from its junction with B9140 Pitfairn Road southwards for a distance of 125 metres or thereby. The experimental traffic order will be in place for up to 18 months and will be used to monitor the effectiveness of the new speed limit on these roads. The experimental traffic order will be in place for up to 18 months and will be used to monitor the effectiveness of the new speed limit on these roads. 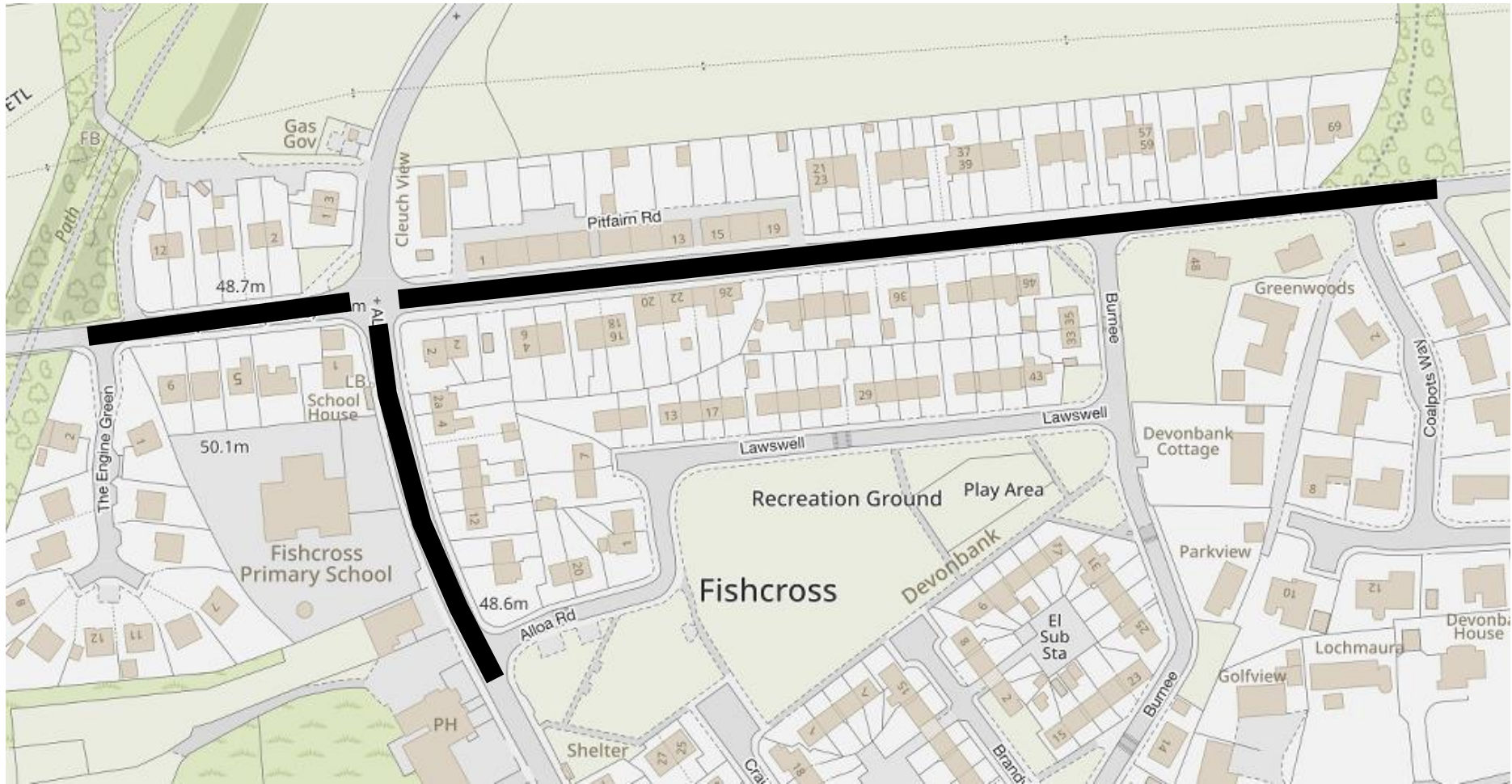
