Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 9, 10 (2), 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (B9140 King O Muirs Road) (50 mph Limit) Experimental Order 2023" and shall come into operation on 2 February 2024 and will apply for a period of up to 18 months.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (3) A speed limit of 50 miles per hour is hereby imposed on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order and no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the said lengths of roads.
- (4) The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- (5) The Strategic Director (Place) of Clackmannanshire Council may, if it appears to them essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient, or safe movement of traffic, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area, and after such consultation and notice as are required by law, modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provisions of it in accordance with Section 10(2) of said Act.
