The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (A977 North of Gartarry Roundabout) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2025" and notwithstanding the date hereof, the Schedule shall come into operation from 1900 hours until 0600 hours each night from Monday 7th July 2025 until Wednesday 9th July 2025.

2. The effect of this Order shall be to is that there will be a temporary road closure during:
