



**(A907 KING STREET, ALLOA)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, PARKING AND LOADING) ORDER 2025**

The Clackmannanshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The Clackmannanshire Council (A907 King Street, Alloa) Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Parking and Loading) Order 2025" and notwithstanding the date hereof, the Schedule 1 shall come into operation from 2315 hours on Saturday 14th February 2026 until 0500 hours on Monday 16th February 2026.
2. The effect of this Order is that there will be no driving, parking and loading at any time during:

The period from 2315 hours on Saturday 14th February 2026 until 0500 hours on Monday 16th February 2026, on the section of roads described in Schedule 1. The temporary prohibition of driving, parking and loading is required to facilitate ironwork repairs for Scottish Water.

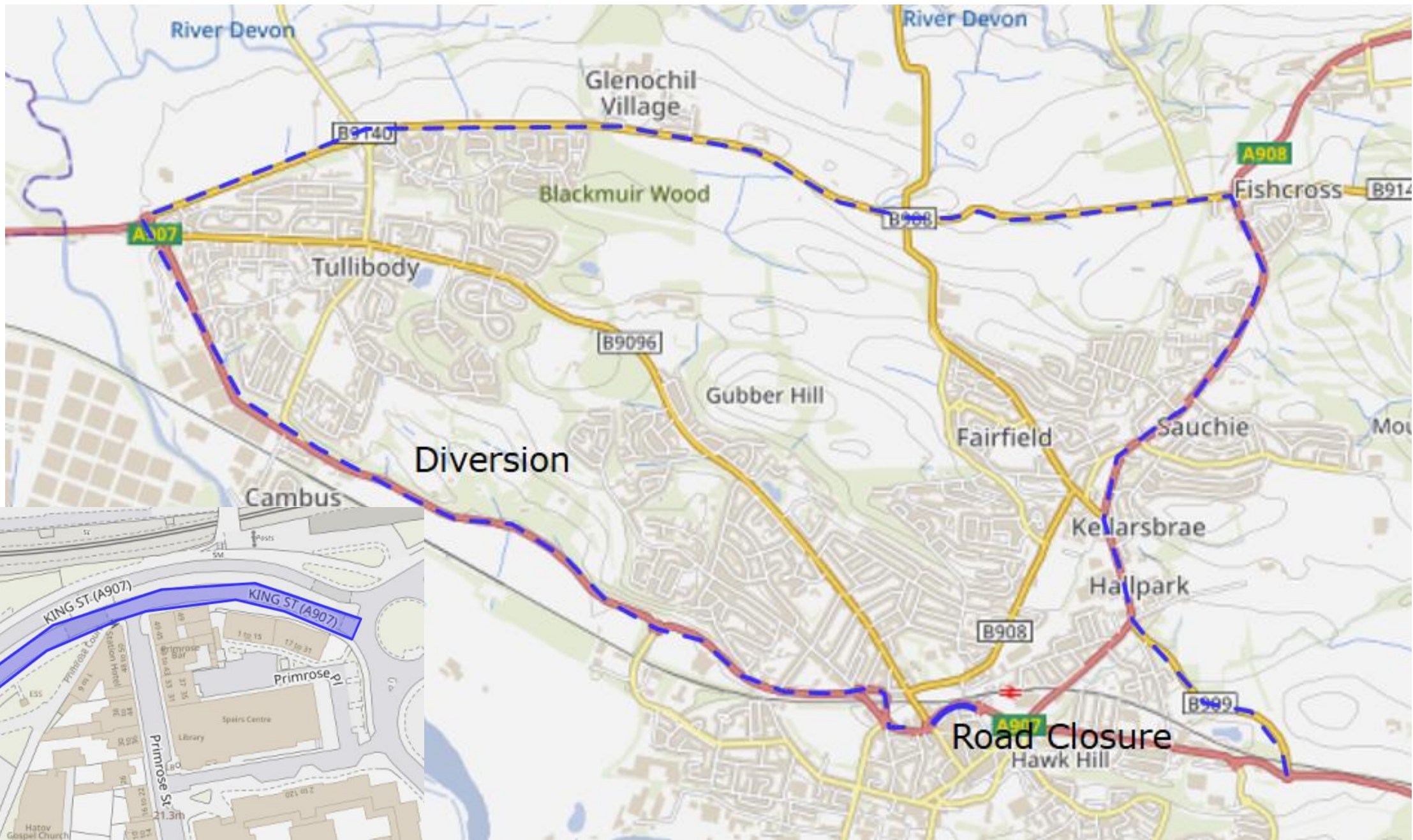
